



## Retreats at YMCA Camp du Nord

Camp du Nord is the perfect location for a rustic, woodsy retreat for your group in a beautiful Northwoods setting.

Limited dates for retreats are available from September through May of each year. Due to our summer camp program, we are unable to host retreats between Memorial Day and Labor Day. Reservations are made on a first-come basis and require a deposit to be put on our calendar.

### Accommodations

We have a variety of accommodations on site ranging from tent sites to full-facility cabins. Depending on the sites available during the time of your event, you'll be able to choose which cabins suit your group best. See the last page for pricing info.

### Facilities

Camp du Nord has great options for gathering spaces! All facilities have seating, but group leaders must provide any materials needed for gatherings and retreats such as office supplies and snacks. Upon request, coffee and tea can be provided for groups who meet at the Dining Hall or Morning Glory.

#### Dining Hall

\$100 reservation fee

Our dining space and the largest building here at du Nord. While most ideal for meals, this building can also be used for yoga and workshops. The Dining Hall has seating for up to 180 people, although smaller groups tend to be more comfortable in the space. This includes 22 (7'10" x 2'11") tables, chairs, a gas fireplace, Wi-Fi, bathrooms, and a covered porch. The west wing of our Dining Hall is available for smaller groups.



#### Morning Glory

\$100 reservation fee

A beautiful building located in our Pine Pointe Village for groups to gather for yoga, discussion, or workshops. Well suited for 20-30 people. Morning Glory features a large stone fireplace, bathrooms, Wi-Fi, and a small kitchen area with a refrigerator.

## Pine Pointe Pavilion

No reservation fee

A large outdoor, covered gathering space located in our Pine Pointe Village. Morning Glory is right next door, so bathrooms are nearby. Excellent spot for yoga, music, or workshops.

### Additional Services and Amenities

One afternoon or evening of saunas can be arranged for groups staying at du Nord for no additional charge.

Guests staying at du Nord have access to canoes and kayaks in the fall and spring for no additional charge.

In the winter skis and snowshoes are available to rent for \$10 per person per day. Individuals can pay on their own at Camp, or the group leader may arrange to pay for all the group's rentals ahead of time.

### Pricing

Deposit due to hold reservation: \$150 for each cabin reserved

Payment due 6 months before the event: 50% of remaining cabin costs

Payment due 1 month before the event: remaining cabin costs

Payment due 1 week before the event: food service costs and any additional changes, if any

### Meal Service

Food service may be arranged for groups of 25 or more during non-programmed fall, winter, and spring seasons. The prices listed are per person/per meal. No charge for children ages 0-3.

Meal service is available for groups of less than 25 people with approval from our kitchen manager. Groups smaller than 25 must pay for a minimum of 25 adult diners per meal. If eating fewer than 3 meals per day, meals must be consecutive (breakfast & lunch or lunch & dinner) each day. Brunch is only available on the day of departure. Meal offerings may vary if other groups are in camp concurrently. Meal numbers, dietary needs, and food payments are due one week before the event.

Each cabin has a full kitchen with dishes, cookware, utensils, a coffeemaker, and a microwave. Some small groups have people bring their own food and prepare meals, and some arrange for potluck meals, or a cooking schedule for their groups.

## **Linens**

Bedding and towels are NOT provided by Camp du Nord. Participants must bring sleeping bags, pillows, and/or sheet sets, and all towels (bath, beach, dish, etc.). Please check [dunord.org](http://dunord.org) if you would like information on bed sizes in each cabin.

## **Set-Up and Clean-Up**

Please keep in mind that there may be other campers in camp unrelated to your event. Any décor or signage must be set up and taken down by the group leader. All campers are expected to clean their own cabins and meeting places at the end of their stay.

## **Event Insurance**

All business parties are required to have liability insurance for their event. Crazy things can happen and we don't want anyone to end up financially responsible for an accident. Check with your current insurance company - you may be able to simply add a rider to an existing policy for the event and YMCA Camp du Nord, or you could check out more comprehensive coverage from event insurance companies online. This protection usually costs between \$30 and \$100 for one day.

## **Deposit and Payment Policies**

A deposit is required to hold your reservation. All reservations are made on a first-come first-served basis.

Any housing changes made after the initial reservation are subject to a \$50 change fee.

50% of the deposit will be refunded if your event is canceled six months or more prior to the scheduled event start date.

50% of the remaining housing costs are due 6 months before the event start date.

The final payment and proof of insurance are due one month before the event. Final numbers for food, food payment, and a participant roster is due one week before the event.

All deposits and payments are non-refundable if your event is canceled less than six months prior to the scheduled event date.



## Lodging Info

There is a two-night minimum on group cabin reservations. The cabin prices listed below are current for the 2024-2025 season. Detailed cabin descriptions and info can be found at [dunord.org](http://dunord.org) under Cabins & Lodging. Exceeding cabin or site capacity by one person of any age is permissible for a fee of \$40 per night. Campers may not exceed the capacity of any cabin by two or more people of any age.

## FULL FACILITY CABINS

The full-facility cabins have bathrooms, full kitchens, and are scenically located. Linens are not included. No pets allowed. Pine Pointe Village cabins, Thor's Lodge, and Jacks II have Wi-Fi. All other cabins and may utilize Wi-Fi in shared community buildings.
